**NEW** Memorial Day Add-ons

We will have a red, white and blue add-on day this Friday, May 26th in observance of Memorial Day. Students may add red, white, and/or blue items to their uniforms such as socks, jewelry, and belts. Appropriate shirts may be worn with the uniform pants, shorts, skirts, or jumpers.


