
## **REMINDER MAP Testing**


There will be no extended day on May 5th as long as there is no rain and Field Day takes place at Belmont Park. If there is rain in the forecast and we need to postpone Field Day, an email and text message will be sent. Dismissal will begin at approximately 12:15 p.m. Any children remaining after 12:45 p.m. will stay with assigned teachers. You will be charged Extended Day late fees if you do not pick your child up by 12:45 p.m.

All adult visitors attending Field Day with their child must be Raptored and will need to wear a school-issued identification badge. The badge must be visible at all times or you will be asked to leave. If you have not had your ID scanned, please stop into the school office tomorrow between 7:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. **There will be no Raptor available the day of.**
