

“HALLOW-GIVING” COSTUME SHOWCASE ***FRIDAY, OCTOBER 30, 2020***



Please refer to the Following Costume guidelines:

- Face masks must be worn with your costume.
- Costumes may not include items that are considered weapons or could be used as weapons such as plastic swords or knives.
- Wigs may be worn, but no colored hair spray or extreme/elaborate make-up is allowed.
- No flip flops or high heels are permitted.
- If students do not wish to wear a costume, they should wear their school uniforms or dress in Halloween colors – orange and black
- All costumes must be appropriate in length and style.
- Costumes should not include any inappropriate sayings or promote violence or inappropriate activity.



As a means in which to turn the focus of Halloween into **Hallow-Giving**, the Student Council would ask student to bring in the following assigned item which will provide much assistance to the ministries our parish supports:

Pre-K: *small shampoos & conditioners*

Kindergarten: *toothpaste*

Grade 1: *tooth brushes*

Grade 2: *stuffing mix*

Grade 3: *cake mix*

Grade 4: *cranberry sauce*

Grade 5: *brown paper bags*

Grade 6: *zip sandwich bags*

Grade 7: *aluminum foil*

Grade 8: *coffee*

The students may bring their items to this weekend's Harvest Mass or bring them to school. From October 26-30, there will be crates positioned at the students' assigned doorway for each specific grade level.
