Please consider the following:

Grade Representative duties include:

1. Serve a two-year term as a representative for your specified class, not to exceed 4 years.
2. Attend meetings (every other month) on the 2nd Tuesday of the month at 6:30 p.m. from August through May.
3. Cannot miss more than three meetings/required events in one school year
4. Act as a liaison between the parents of your grade and the Executive Board/Administration on fundraising, service, and social activities of the school. This includes soliciting event volunteers from your grade.
5. Work with the Executive Committee to develop and fulfill ideas to strengthen the PHSA and St. Ursula School and Parish.
6. Encourage communication between parents, Executive Committee, and Administration for the purpose of fostering sincere appreciation for the ideas of Catholic education.
7. Perform special duties as assigned by the President or Principal – including attending required events (New Parent Welcome, Back to School Nights, Open Houses, and Teacher Appreciation Dinner).

Tuition and all fees must be current and service hours completed. PHSA positions are an integral part of a successful school year for St. Ursula and our students.
