Peace be with you.

I am pleased to share an important update regarding system improvements across our Catholic schools.

The Archdiocese of Baltimore will transition to the FACTS Student Information System (SIS), with full implementation beginning in the 2027–2028 school year. As part of this transition, re-enrollment for the 2027–2028 school year beginning in Fall 2026 will take place entirely within FACTS.

Currently, our schools use multiple platforms to manage different functions: Finalsite Enrollment for applications and enrollment, PowerSchool for student information, and FACTS for financial management. While each system serves an important role, managing multiple platforms can be complex for families and school staff. Moving to FACTS SIS will unify enrollment, academic, and financial information into one integrated, secure, and user-friendly system.

We are excited about this transition and the opportunity it provides to improve efficiency, consistency, and communication across our schools.

As part of this launch, families will have access to the FACTS Family Portal, where you will be able to:

- View your child's academic information
- Complete enrollment and required school forms
- Access tuition and financial information and make payments

Please note that each parent or guardian must have a unique email address on file with your school to access the FACTS Family Portal. This is necessary to ensure secure and accurate access.

We understand that transitions like this may bring questions. We are committed to supporting our families and school communities every step of the way. Additional details, including timelines and guidance, will be shared by your school as we prepare for full implementation.

Thank you for your continued partnership in Catholic education and for the trust you place in our schools. As we move forward, we remain grounded in our shared mission to educate the whole child—mind, body, and spirit.

May God bless our efforts, guide this transition, and continue to watch over our students, families, and educators.
