May - Peace

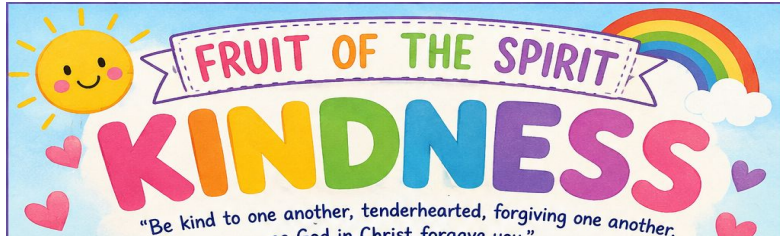
Monthly Saints

Classroom	Be respectful of others. Be truthful.	Work together. Follow directions.	Bring supplies to class. Stay focused on the task.
Hallway	Keep hands and feet to yourself. Respect others' personal space.	Pay attention - eyes forward.	Move quickly and quietly to class.
Lunchroom	Pray before eating.	Raise your hand for help. Use an indoor voice.	Walk safely to the lunchroom. Leave the table and floor clean.
Restroom	Respect others' privacy. Be patient.	Keep water and soap in the sink. Only 2-3 people at a time. Wait my turn.	Go, flush, and wash.
Playground/Recess	Treat others kindly. Share the equipment.	Follow the rules for safe play. Take turns & include everyone.	Use good sportsmanship.
Church	Be respectful of others. Listen attentively.	Follow the rules for safely walking to mass. Sit in the assigned area.	Actively participate in mass through prayer and song.

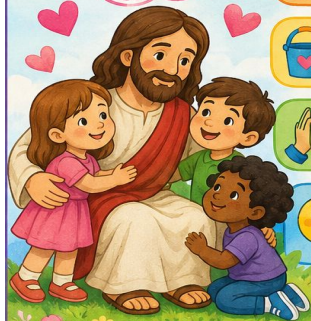
