## SAINT OF THE WEEK

### *Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton*

Elizabeth Ann Seton, also known as Mother Seton, is the first saint to be born in the United States. After her husband passed, Elizabeth moved her family to Emmitsburg, Maryland and founded the Sisters of Charity of St. Joseph. This was the first community of religious women established in the United States. Mother Seton is the patron saint of Catholic schools, widows, and seafarers.
