St. Theresa of Calcutta

Agnes Bojaxhiu was born on August 26, 1910 in Skopje, Macedonia. She took the name Mother Teresa during her vows and later started her own religious order called "The Missionaries of Charity." She continued her mission opening 150 charity foundations as well as orphanages, nursing homes, and health clinics. She was canonized September 4, 2016 by Pope Francis and we celebrate her feast day on September 5. She is the patron saint of World Youth Day and of Calcutta, India.
