Saint Francis Zavier

Francis Xavier was a Spanish missionary priest who spent 11 years preaching and teaching in India and Japan. In 1534 he joined St. Ignatius Loyola and formed the Society of Jesus, better known as the Jesuits. He was canonized in 1622.
