adults received housing and employment support



Since its inception in 1996, the Archdiocese of Baltimore's **Partners in Excellence (PIE) Scholarship Program** has awarded **\$38,035,153 in nearly 30,000 tuition assistance grants** to families who otherwise could not afford the cost of a Catholic school education for their children.



In 2022, **155 Camp GLOW retreatants** participated in this annual summer tradition, strengthening their relationship with the Lord through the celebration of Mass and other spiritual activities as well as many opportunities for fun and fellowship.


## Ministries by the Numbers (2022)




















The Archdiocese supports relief programs that are embedded in Latin America, Ukraine, and Haiti, as well as a host of other national and global evangelization programs.
