As a member of the Parish, Home and School Association (PHSA) I promise to promote academic excellence, spiritual formation, and faith in action and environmental stewardship in our world as stated in the Mission Statement for St. Ursula School.

I understand that as a member of the PHSA I also pledge to do the following:

- Attendance at meetings is mandatory. 2 absences a year are allowed; absences should be reported to the President at least 48 hours before the scheduled meeting time. Those missing more than 2 meetings per year may not be considered for the PHSA in the future.
- Be punctual. If tardiness is unavoidable please enter meeting quietly in an effort to not disturb the meeting.
- 3. In order to have minimal interruptions:
 - All cell phones should be turned off before meetings.
 - · Children are not permitted at any meeting.
 - "Side Banter" is a disruption to the meeting and should be kept to a minimum. It
 makes it very difficult for other PHSA members to hear the discussion.

- Proper attire when representing St. Ursula School at formal events (Back-to-School Night, Open Houses, etc.)

 up to the school principal outside of the context of the PHSA meetings.
- PHSA representatives working as liaisons to the school fundraisers and events should report on their duties when applicable.
