Fall MAP scores will be coming home with your child today for students in grades 2-8.

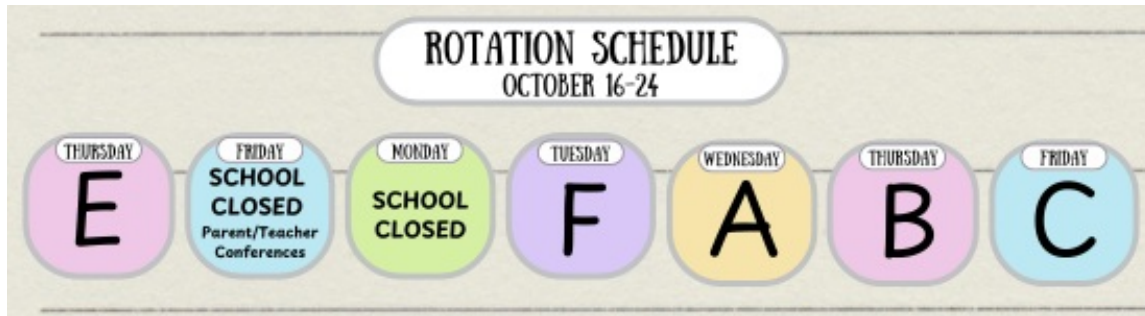
