## SAINT OF THE WEEK

### *St. Therese of Lisieux*

St. Therese was born on January 2nd, 1873 in Alençon, France. Two days after she was born, she was baptized at

Notre Dame Church. St. Therese is known as the little flower of Jesus. She was canonized on May 17, 1925. In 1997, St. Therese was declared a Doctor of the Church by Pope John Paul II, making her the second Carmelite nun to receive that distinction.
