
We are looking forward to Harvest Festival next week! Please see the Harvest Festival section below for information on attending the festival, donations needed, and more.

I will come on the intercom and say, "Lock, Lights Out, and Out of Sight," two times. We will absolutely stress to the students that this is just practice. During this time teachers will lock their classroom doors, take attendance, and help students find a location in the room out of sight. It is important that students pay close attention to their teacher's instructions for lockdown procedures. Remember, a Lockdown is an emergency situation and our goal is to practice so we know what to do. Classes will discuss the Lockdown drill during school time as well.

Over the next two weeks our school will be partnering with The Pulsera Project, a fair trade nonprofit organization that seeks to empower, inspire, and educate people in Central America and the U.S. The Pulsera Project provides sustainable, well-paying work opportunities for artisans in Nicaragua and Guatemala, most of whom make colorful hand-woven bracelets, or "pulseras" in Spanish.

Students may purchase these items during the Harvest Festival on Thursday, 10/12 (cash only, no tickets). They will also be available during morning homeroom in Mrs. Marinaro's office the week of 10/16.
