
Thank you for your generous donations of cereal for our Lenten service project. We collected 230 boxes of cereal which were donated to the St. Vincent de Paul Society!

NEW Field Day

Field Day will be held Friday, May 2nd atDouble Rock Park, located at 8211 Glen Road, Parkville, MD 21234. All students should arrive at Double Rock Park no later than 8:30 a.m.

There will be no Extended Day on May 2nd as long as there is no rain and Field Day takes place at Double Rock Park. If there is rain in the forecast and we need to postpone Field Day, an email and text message will be sent. Dismissal will begin at approximately 12:15 p.m. Any children remaining after 12:30 p.m. will stay with assigned teachers and you will be charged Extended Day late fees.

All adult visitors attending Field Day with their child must be Raptored and will need to wear a school-issued identification badge. The badge must be visible at all times or you will be asked to leave. To make this process as smooth as possible, please complete the form linked below so we can have your badge printed. Badges will be provided to you when you check in with your child's teacher on Field Day. You are welcome to come to the school office so we can scan your ID if you have not already done so. **Please only complete this form if you have previously given your driver's license to the main office** The form is due by 3:30 p.m. on Tuesday, April 29th.
