Additionally, please note that next year's school calendar is included below. We encourage you to take some time to review it for your planning purposes.

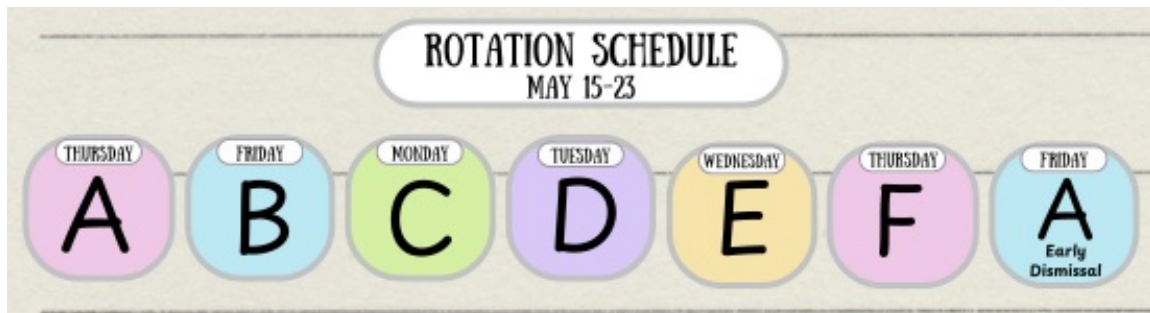
