Good Afternoon Huskies!

Tomorrow is our first Dollar Day! If you did not pay using the link last week in the What's Ahead Wednesday you can bring a dollar tomorrow! Please make sure that you follow the dress code requirements in the handbook.

STAR Week for the SUS House System has been going well! As of today, at 3:30 the St. Bernadette (Blue) House is in the lead. Reminder that students obtain points for their House by going above and beyond expectations.

In an effort to make sure all students arrive at school safely please help us with the following two items.

- 1. Make sure that you do not arrive before 7:40AM. We do not have supervision for students available before 7:40AM.
- 2. Use the car line for morning arrival drop-off or park at the St. Ursula church to let your child walk to the school. Please do not park at the St. John's lot and cross the street.

This morning we practiced the Hold drill. It was very successful and our students did a great job. Next week on October 3rd, we will practice our Secure drill at 10 a.m. We use this drill if there are situations nearby that require us to remain in the building with doors locked. During the Secure drill we will tell teachers and students to return to the building. Students will remain actively engaged in learning activities since this is not an emergency and teachers will conduct business as usual with extra vigilance to our surroundings. During a Secure event no one enters or leaves the building.

Our 8th grade class took the first field trip of the school year yesterday to

Emmitsburg. During this field trip students were able to visit the Seton Shrine and the Grotto. They represented our SUS community so well. Thank you to the 8th grade teachers and volunteers for such a fun day!
